

Danish Language Course for Foreign University Students

Copenhagen, 22 July – 9 August 2013

How to apply - Instruction and Information

The Summer Language Course in Danish under the Cultural Agreements programme is free of charge and open to bachelor, Master's and Ph.D. students enrolled in a full-degree program in one of the following countries or at the following universities:

- Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Great Britain, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Italy, Japan, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Serbia, Slovak Republic, Spain, Switzerland, The Netherlands, and Turkey.
- University of British Columbia, Department of Central, Eastern and Northern European Studies, Vancouver, Canada; Portland State University, Dept. of Foreign Lang. and Literature, Portland, OR, USA; University of California, Department of Scandinavian Studies, Berkeley, Ca, USA; University of Texas at Austin, Department of Germanic Studies, Austin, TX, USA; University of Washington, Scandinavian Department, Seattle, WA, USA; University of Wisconsin, Department of Scandinavian Studies, Madison, WI, USA; University of California, The Scandinavian Section, Los Angeles, CA, USA.

With the acceptance for the course follows a scholarship of DKK 5000 which will be handed out on 22 July - the first day of the course.

This summer course is offered by the Danish Cultural Institute in co-operation with the Copenhagen Center for Adult Education (KVUC). The course administrator is the Danish Cultural Institute, Vartov, Farvergade 27 L, 1463 Copenhagen K. The teaching takes place at KVUC, Vognmagergade 8, 1120 Copenhagen K in the city centre of Copenhagen with perfect study facilities, modern IT-equipment and good canteen facilities. At the very same period about 600 Danish students follow classes at KVUC - to improve their knowledge and skills in specific subjects/ levels required by the university.

Please fill out the application form (on the computer or alternatively by hand). The application form must be completed in Danish or English. Remember to sign and write the date on the application, when you are finished.

Please mail the application form to The Danish Cultural Institute, Merete Agger, as soon as possible and not later than 22 March, 2013.

Ultimo April you will receive an e-mail with the outcome of your application.

Optional: Enclose a recommendation from a lecturer who teaches/has taught you in Danish or from the Director of the Danish Cultural Institute in your country.
